The Thursday Group Privacy Notice

The Thursday Group Membership Secretary will be the 'Controller' of the personal data you provide to us. Updates Editors, committee members and other members nominated by the committee will be 'Processors' of selected data required to undertake their roles.

The Thursday Group only collects basic personal data about you which does not include any special types of information. The data we hold include your name, address, email address, and phone number(s).

Why we need your data

We need to know your basic personal data in order to be able to communicate with you and where necessary to provide you with updates and information.

We will not collect any personal data from you we do not need in order to provide and oversee this service to you. We only store and process your personal data on the basis of our legitimate interests.

What we do with your data

All the personal data we hold on you is processed in the UK. No third parties have access to your personal data unless the law allows them to do so.

How long we keep your data

Your information will be kept by us until you notify us that you no longer wish to receive any communication or information from us or you leave the group.

What are your rights

If at any point you believe the information we process on you is incorrect you can request to see this information and have it corrected or deleted.
